District and Consortium hereby mutually agree to the following conditions:

- The fiscal agent agrees to file a Perkins Local Plan as part of the annual grant application and required reports with the SD Department of Education.
- The fiscal agent is responsible for the use of all grant funds and ensuring that the project is carried out by the consortium members in accordance with federal law.
- Each member LEA is legally responsible to carry out the activities it agrees to perform and use funds and items that it receives through the consortium in accordance with federal requirements that apply to the grant.
- Each LEA will have one authorized representative on the consortium board.
- The budget and Perkins Local Application for the consortium shall be developed by the Consortium CTE Administrator and the consortium board.
- The Consortium CTE Administrator and fiscal agent agree to assist member LEAs through regular communication and provide leadership for the implementation of the Perkins Local Plan.
- All items purchased will remain the property of the consortium. Should the LEA leave the consortium, disposition of consortium-owned equipment physically located on the grounds of the departing LEA is at the discretion of the consortium director, in consultation with the consortium board.
- The fiscal agent will provide a plan for the final disposition of equipment and materials purchased with Perkins funds.
- Each LEA is bound to the conditions in the grant application, will adhere to the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act and other assurances as listed as part of the grant application, and will maintain records and other support materials to ensure all conditions and assurances are met.
- The Consortium CTE Administrator agrees to coordinate and maintain all material, data, documents, and records to assure that consortium and member LEAs are meeting federal and state requirements for monitoring, fiscal reporting (including budget modifications), and other related items that impact upon the requirements of the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act.
- For purposes of Perkins federal accountability reporting and program improvement, the LEAs and Perkins Director agree to use safe and secure methods when accessing and reviewing data in accordance with FERPA.
- The consortium director will serve as the data custodian for the consortium.

Shared Goals

The LEA's allocation transferred to the consortium shall be used for purposes and programs that are for the shared goals which are mutually beneficial to all consortium members.

The fiscal agent of the consortium may not subgrant back to the participating LEAs the amounts they contributed to the consortium. (Code of Federal Regulations 34 CFR Part 403 Subpart E)

Part 2: Perkins Report Card Data Sharing Agreement
